Mike Williams, U.S. Navy Corpsman aboard the U.S.S. Hancock, an attack aircraft carrier. In the Gulf of Tonkin 1972-73, Vietnam. Sergeant at Arms at the Brainerd VFW and Honor Guard/Color Guard member.

Mark Persons, an Army sergeant, served on a small airbase in southern Vietnam 1968-69. He did high-tech electronic work to keep airplanes flying. Now Webmaster at the Brainerd VFW.

Mark Persons: Our nation's defense touches all of us and it is not just a three-day holiday. Memorial Day ceremonies were held at the veteran cemetery at Camp Ripley on Sunday, May 28th honoring those who gave the ultimate sacrifice. Ceremonies were held the next day in Brainerd.

Here are the facts: 116.000 American servicemen died in WWI.

440,000 American servicemen and women died in WWII defending freedom globally against the totalitarian powers of Germany and Japan. Get this, Germany and Japan were going to divide the U.S. at the Mississippi River.

Korea 36.000 died.

Vietnam 58,000 died. I knew three.

War on Terror 4500 and counting.

Some 1.3 million died serving America in the defense of freedom over the years.

4th of July parade in Brainerd. We were freed from foreign rule starting in 1776.

Ron Specker: Camp Ripley Open House Sunday, September 17th starting at 10 am

Mark Persons: I attended the Oshkosh AirVenture last week. They reported 677,000 attendees. There were two air accidents while I was there and I didn't see them happen. For perspective, the Minnesota State Fair is 322 acres. At Oshkosh it is 1500 acres. That is more than four times the size. A WWII trainer aircraft crashed into Lake Winnibago, about eight miles away killing two. A small helicopter and a gyrocopter collided mid-air, killing two and injuring two.

The FAA is doing investigations. Airspace at any airport is tightly controlled. They will find someone wasn't where he or she should have been at the moment of the mid-air collision.
